The reasons we recommend citing sources are as follows: to give credit to authors whose works are used, to provide a trail by which others can locate the materials, to supply evidence of research, and to avoid plagiarism.

How to Cite Sources

This book uses the most common style guide, the MLA, for reference. The MLA is the most used citation style guide in most school districts. For this book, we do require a URL listing from the students.




